This calendar is subject to change due to weather, staffing, or unforeseen cancellations and closures. All rules and policies are still in place while on field trips. Should your student be disciplined for breaking Club rules and policies prior to our trips, staff will determine his/her eligibility to attend.

Our School Age Summer Program provides students (grades 3-5) with dynamic programming and field trips to enhance our members' physical, social, and academic well-being. Through funding provided by our 21st Century Community Center Learning grant, our staff will work hard this summer to ensure that we are providing all students with unique learning enrichments, character education experiences, arts, multi-cultural studies, and health & nutrition practices.

What Does My Student Need to Bring?

Students **MUST** have a water bottle, sunscreen, change of clothes, bathing Suit and towel.

For Daily Clothing: Please pack clothing that your students can run around in, climb in, and play in without the clothing falling/slipping off.

For Bathing Suits: Please pack athletic, functional bathing suits. Acceptable bathing suits include a one piece, or tankini, with no way to unhook, untie, or unzip.

Swim trunks should provide full coverage and fitted around the waist, so they won't accidentally slip off.

We will be spending a lot of time outside, swimming, jumping, etc. We want to ensure that our students be able to participate fully in these activities by wearing clothing and bathing suits that will allow for safety, full range of motion, functionality, or slipping off to cause inappropriate exposure.

Students that attend field trip days are required to attend the trips.

Students are not permitted to wear sweatshirts during the summer to prevent heat exhaustion. Blankets, pajamas, toys, and stuffed animals are not permitted.

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Some of our activities require parental waivers to participate. Please see the calendar for these highlighted events and be sure to fill out the required waivers in advance.
